Our year was finally here, we were the largest ever Senior Class...JoNell Rugenstein was president, Steve Davis, Vice President, Jeanne Fletcher, Secretary, and Bob Humes, Treasurer...This was our year to shine. Susan Peters was editor-in-chief of the Booster; JoNell Rugenstein was in charge of the Ivian; Bill Jones won recognition in both football and track; Pete Van Dyke was named to All City in football; Lee Gadiant was the City and Sectional Champ in his class in wrestling; Larry Breimeir and Dave Ellis won the Chrysler Trouble Shooting Contest; Ralph Tacoma was named the city's best ROTC cadet; and we had four National Merit finalists, Ralph Tacoma, Joe O'Brien, and Lynn and Lane Charnes...Our teams beat Southport in both basketball and baseball and tied them in football.
